

Multi-Sensory Room at Spennymoor Leisure Centre – Video Transcript

[Background music plays throughout video]

[Background music plays as video filming speeds 'fast forward' through scenes of people and busses arriving at the leisure centre, entering the building reception area and then moving through the corridors.]

[Video images fade out and then re-image at a doorway which is sign posted Spennymoor Multi-Sensory Room. A lady with young children go into the room.]

[The children start playing in the room, which has coloured lighting on one wall and part of the floor. Also, in the room are some large, free standing, coloured light lit liquid bubble columns and a yellow lit free-standing screen. There are some large seating cushions on the floor. A child picks up and sits with an interactive pad near the lit wall and changes the colour of the wall lighting. Other children join in.]

[Text on screen continues: that stimulates the senses, inspires the imagination and helps make sense of the world. The text displays over a background scene of liquid bubble columns.]

[A text heading on screen reads: Enhance vision and movement.]

[The children walk on an area of floor that has large square tiles which light up when stood on].

[Coloured fibre optic cables are hanging near the coloured floor tile area.]

[A table top features a moving image.]

[A text heading on screen reads: Find private spaces.]

[The camera pans around the room as the children play, run and jump onto the large, soft, seating cushions in an area of the room which is lit in green.]

The walls and screens have changing coloured lights and light images. One of the wall screens shows images of birds and others have projections of coloured light and patterns.

As the camera pans around the room it shows textures on the wall, fibre optic coloured light cables hanging as a curtain and coloured light tubes with rising bubbles.]

[Text on screen continues: or enjoy group interaction.]

[A text heading on screen reads: Explore colour]

[Text on screen continues: shapes and textures.]

[A text heading on screen reads: Discover light, sound]

[Text on screen continues: and space.]

[A text heading on screen reads: Relax using aromatherapy oils]

[Text on screen continues: on the vibration water bed.]

[A text heading on screen reads: Chill out]

[Text on screen continues: or interact]

[Text on screen continues: using colour and touch.]

[A text heading on screen reads: unwind, watch and listen.]

[A text heading on screen reads: Sessions available for pre-school children and adults and children with a special educational need or disability.]

[A text heading on screen reads: Discover all your senses]

[Text on screen continues: in the multi-sensory room.]
