

## **Terms & Conditions**

1. The new corporate health and fitness membership scheme will start on 01 April 2011, and will override any previous schemes throughout Durham County Leisure, although previous schemes will be honoured for the duration of the contract period.
2. All memberships will run for a minimum 12 month period from the date of joining.
3. The membership fee will be based on the option chosen and will be a percentage of the standard membership package in place at the specific leisure centre joined, and rounded to the nearest £1.
4. Memberships can be paid either:
  - Through a monthly direct debit which may include a small premium to cover the costs of that service (details available upon request).
  - Paid In full at the time of joining.
  - Official Durham County Leisure Vouchers (proportion of).
5. All members will have to complete a full 12 months from the date of joining and Durham County Council reserves the right to collect money for this period if the member leaves before the 12 month period is over. (Those with exceptional circumstances wishing to leave the corporate scheme before the 12 month period is up, will need to make a request in writing to the manager of the leisure centre they have joined at).
6. The corporate membership scheme is open to all organisations that meet the requirements of the three highlighted options.
7. Durham County Council reserves the right to check proof of employment of any individual at any time.
8. Durham County Council will allow members to suspend monthly payments if within the parameters of the leisure centres' cancellation policies.
9. Durham County Council will consider the suspension of Direct Debit payments for members who experience other extraordinary circumstances which will prevent their use of the facilities. However the Council reserves the right to be the sole judge thereof.
10. Durham County Council reserves the right not to offer Direct Debit payment facilities to any applicants.
11. Durham County Council reserves the right to change the activities, prices and services included within any of the health and fitness membership packages at any time.
12. Should any circumstances affecting the member's suitability to participate in exercise arise, it is the responsibility of the individual to seek medical advice before undertaking activity.

13. Not all activities and services included within the Durham County Council's health and fitness memberships will be available at all leisure centres.
14. These conditions are in addition to the general regulations operated by all Durham County Leisure venues.
15. Any company or organisation not meeting the commitments within the signed agreement may be removed from the corporate health and fitness membership scheme.
16. Numbers of participating leisure centres may change.
