

**The County Council of Durham
(Various Roads and Footpaths, Durham City)
(Temporary Road and Footpath Closure)
Order 2024**

The County Council of Durham on 05/07/2024 made an Order under the provisions of Section 16(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, as amended by the Road Traffic Regulation (Special Events) Act 1994, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit all traffic, on the following lengths of roads and footpaths for the Durham City Run special event between 3.00pm and 9.30pm unless specified:

**A. Roads closed to vehicular traffic except for emergency service access
(4.00pm to 9.30pm)**

1. Owengate (3.00pm-9.30pm)
2. Market Place including High Street, Saddler Street including Saddler Lane junction, Elvet Bridge,
3. Silver Street and Framwellgate Bridge

**B. Roads closed to vehicular traffic (except for emergency service access)
and access under Event Control convoy vehicle (3.00pm-9.30pm)**

1. Millburngate (southbound) from A690 and Framwellgate Waterside (northbound) to and including the main access to the Radisson Blu Hotel, **except** under the direction of convoy vehicle

C. Roads closed to vehicular traffic except for emergency service access

1. Framwellgate Waterside from Frankland Lane and Sidegate to the main access to the Radisson Blu Hotel, and also closed to southbound traffic only to the junction with Millburngate (3.00 pm to 9.30 pm with exit from Millburngate Car Park permitted before 6.15 pm and after 8.15 pm)
2. North Road between its junctions with Millburngate and Framwellgate Bridge/Crossgate (4.00pm and 9.30 pm)
3. Crossgate between its junctions with North Road/Framwellgate Bridge to and including the junction with South Street (6.15 and 8.15 pm)
4. South Street between its junctions with Crossgate to and including its junction with Grove Street (6.15 and 8.15 pm)
5. Pimlico from its junction with Grove Street to its junction with Quarryheads Lane (6.15 and 8.15 pm)
6. Quarryheads Lane from its junction with Pimlico to its junction with South Road/Stockton Road traffic signals (6.15 and 8.15 pm)
7. Potters Bank between its junctions with Quarryheads Lane and Elvet Hill Road junction (6.15 and 8.15 pm)
8. Church Street between Oswald Court junction to New Elvet (6.15 and 8.30 pm)
9. New Elvet between Court Lane to and including St Andrews Court junction (6.15 and 8.15 pm)

10. New Elvet from St Andrews Court junction to A690 Leazes Bowl (6.15 and 9.30 pm)
11. Old Elvet between New Elvet and Whinney Hill (6.30 and 8.30 pm)
12. Territorial Lane between its junctions with Old Elvet and Elvet Waterside (6.30 and 9.30 pm)
13. Elvet Waterside from its junction with Territorial Lane and extending eastwards (6.30 and 9.30 pm)
14. Green Lane in its entirety (6.30 and 8.30 pm)
15. Claypath between the Prince Bishops Car Park roundabout to the junction with the A690-Claypath eastbound slip road junction (6.30-9.30 pm)
16. Claypath from and including the A690-Claypath eastbound slip road junction to and including the Providence Row junction (6.00-9.30 pm)
17. The A690 eastbound one-way slip to Claypath (6.30pm-8.00 pm)
18. Providence Row from and including the Claypath junction to and including the Freemans Place junction (6.45-8.00pm)
19. Freemans Place between Providence Row and the access to Durham Sixth Form Centre (6.45pm-8.00pm)
20. Freemans Place between the footpath leading to Pennyferry Bridge and the steps south of HM Passport Office (6.45pm-8.00pm)
21. North Bailey from Saddler Street/Owengate to the junction with Bow Lane (6.15pm-9.30pm)

D. One-way restrictions to vehicular traffic

1. Millburngate between the Framwellgate Waterside junction and North Road (closed southbound only) (3.00pm-9.30pm)
2. New Elvet/Hallgarth Street from Job Centre to Court Lane (closed northbound only) (6.15 and 8.30 pm)
3. Church Street from Stockton Road New Inn traffic signalled junction to Oswald Court (closed north eastbound only) making No Entry from South Road into Church Street north of Oswald Court (6.15 and 8.30 pm)

E. Prohibition of Left Turn Restrictions to vehicular traffic

1. From Palmers Garth onto Elvet Crescent toward New Elvet (6.15 and 8.30 pm)

F. Prohibition of Right Turn Restrictions to vehicular traffic

1. From Court Lane to New Elvet (6.15 and 9.30 pm)
2. From Stockton Road to Church Street (6.15 and 8.15 pm)
3. Boyd Street to Church Street (6.15 and 8.15 pm)
4. Oswald Court to Church Street (6.15 and 8.30 pm)

G. Suspension of Existing Traffic Restriction

1. No through road at Sidegate as detailed in the County Council of Durham (Durham City Zone 2)(Traffic Management) Order 2001 for traffic exiting onto A691 (3.00pm to 9.30pm)

H. Public Footpaths closed to pedestrian traffic 6.30 pm and 9.30 pm

1. Baths Bridge
2. A 1255 metre length Footpath No. 48 Durham Parish from opposite River Court on Green Lane extending to the riverside and continuing east and south past the Amateur Rowing Club to the gate onto Green Lane
3. Footpath 41 between Green Lane and the Houghall Campus
4. Footpath 54 at Houghall from Footpath 41 to the footbridge over the River Wear
5. Footpath 80 between the Houghall Footbridge and extending along the river bank to Pelaw Wood and Footpath 78
6. Footpath No 78 Durham Parish extending westwards from Footpath 80 to Baths Bridge
7. Pennyferry Bridge including links at either side to Framwellgate Waterside and Freemans Place

The requirements in this Order are to safeguard members of the public and participants whilst the Durham City Run special event takes place. The Order will be effective from 3.00 pm on Thursday 18 July 2024. The anticipated duration of the restrictions is up to 6¹/₂ hours on Thursday evening with additional closures of H2 required on Friday 19/07/24 for the Run Like a Legend event between 10.00 am and 5.00 pm.

Alternative routes will be signed to vehicular traffic during the closures via A177 to A167 Cock O' the North, then north to Nevilles Cross and east on A690 to Leazes Bowl Roundabout, and vice versa. Additional diversions will be signed from Potters Bank via Elvet Hill Road to A177 South Road.
