TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (CONTROL OF ADVERTISEMENTS) (ENGLAND) REGULATIONS 2007 PROPOSED DIRECTION UNDER REGULATION 7 TO CONTROL

THE DISPLAY OF 'TO LET' BOARDS

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of Durham ("the Council") on 28 June 2018 made representations to the Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government requesting that he makes a direction under Regulation 7 of the Town and Country Planning (Control of Advertisements) (England) Regulations 2007 ("the 2007 Regulations") to restrict the display of temporary advertisements relating to the letting of residential land or premises which are displayed on the land or premises to which they relate within areas of Durham City Centre Conservation Area.

The effect of a Direction under Regulation 7 of the 2007 Regulations would be to take away the deemed consent granted by Regulation 6 of the 2007 Regulations to temporary advertisements described in Class 3A in Part 1 of Schedule 3 to the 2007 Regulations in so far as it relates to temporary advertisements for the letting of residential land or premises. This would mean that no temporary advertisement signs for the letting of residential properties could be displayed on the land or premises to which they relate in the prescribed area without the Council's express consent.
