Notice of publication of Sedgefield Neighbourhood Plan proposal under Regulation 16 of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 and the Localism Act 2011

This notice is published to inform the public that the Sedgefield Neighbourhood Plan has been submitted to Durham County Council for consultation.

Sedgefield Town Council have prepared a neighbourhood development plan – known as 'The Sedgefield Plan' – with the help of the local community. The plan provides a vision for the future of Sedgefield in 2033 and sets out land use policies which will be used to determine planning applications in the neighbourhood plan area.

This is a repeat of the Submission Consultation stage (Regulation 16) at the request of the examiner. The examination has been suspended to permit this, however it will recommence at the close of this consultation on 2<sup>nd</sup> April 2019. A successful examination outcome will ensure that the Neighbourhood Plan can be considered for adoption (via a local referendum).


