- Neighbourhood Budget funding proposals **approved**, as follows:
 - **Acle Scouts Storage Unit**

NB funding allocation £2,000; total project cost £3,090.

 - **School Aycliffe Community Association Furniture**
(Cllrs Adam & Hopper)
NB funding allocation £4,000; total project cost £4,324.

 - **Middridge Tree Maintenance**
(Cllrs Clare, Durham & Howell)
NB funding allocation £1,800; total project cost £1,812.

- Area Budget funding allocations for 2019-20 **AGREED** as follows, to be allocated by means of an open project callout launching in the new financial year:

- Project Grant limits agreed for the callout, between £5k-£20k.

- All future project applications must include a minimum of 5% match funding, either financial or in-kind, in order to be eligible.

- Future projects will be encouraged to include an element of capital expenditure.

- Funding update given in relation to 2018-19 allocations; Area Budget, Welfare Reform, Youth Fund and Older Persons Social Isolation Fund.
