Information for prisoners on paying for care and support

Information for prisoners on paying for care and support services

If you have a social care assessment from G4S and it is recommended that you receive services you will need to have a financial assessment.

A financial assessment is the way that we work out how much you can afford to pay towards the cost of your care and support.

The amount you will have to pay depends on the help you need and the income and savings you have.

- If you have income and savings of more than £23,250 you will need to pay the full cost of your care
- If your income and savings are between £14,250 and £23,250 you will need to make a contribution
- If you have a pension from a previous workplace we will need to know about this

If you need to pay for your care and support we will let you know how much you have to pay and how to pay.
