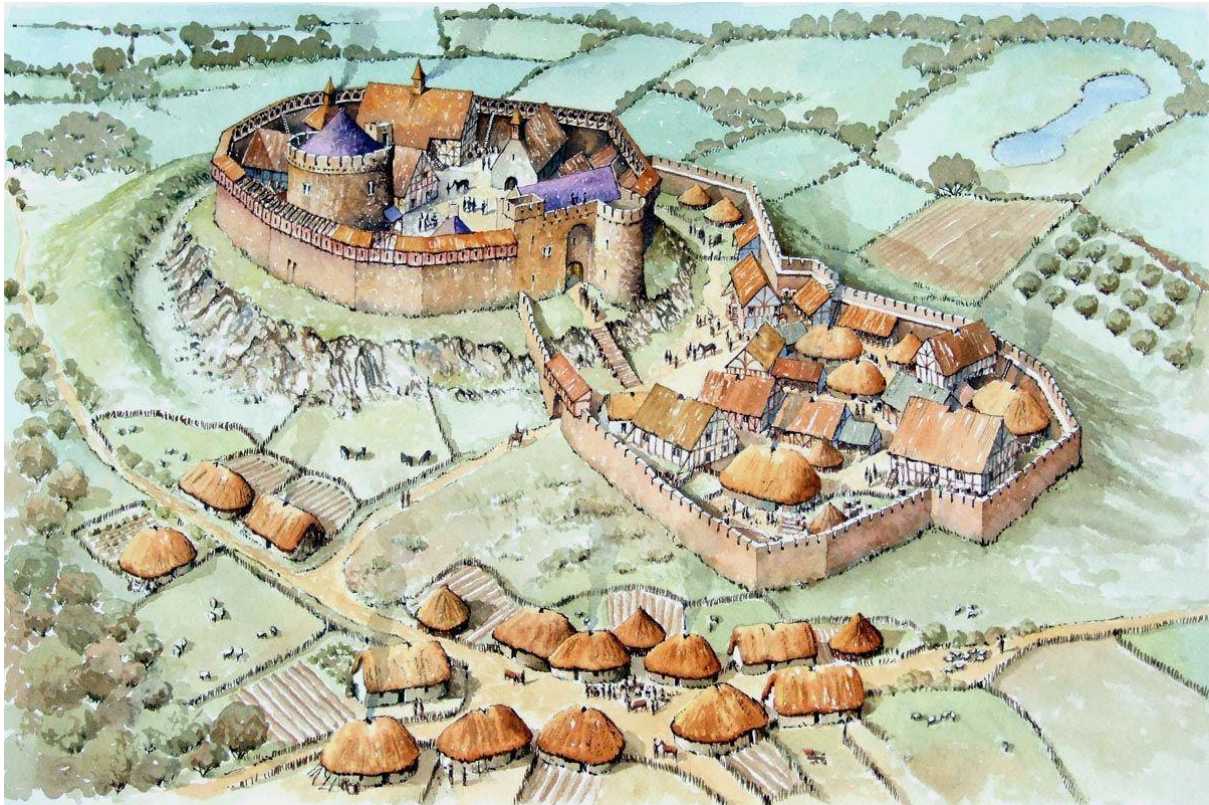


Sheet 3 Medieval Castle and Village
