NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR REGISTRATION OF LAND AS A TOWN OR VILLAGE GREEN

To every reputed owner, lessee, tenant or occupier of any part of the land described below, and to all others whom it may concern.

Application has been made to the Commons Registration Authority, Durham County Council by Dr Anthony Amatrudo, 120 Gilesgate, Durham, under section 15(1) of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with the Commons (Registration of Town or Village Greens) (Interim Arrangements) (England) Regulations 2007. The application seeks the inclusion in the register of town and village greens of the land described in the Schedule below which is claimed to have qualified for registration as a town or village green on 14 February 2012, by virtue of use for lawful sports and pastimes as of right for not less than 20 years. The activities claimed to take place include dog walking and children playing.

If the registration authority is satisfied that the land described below qualifies for registration as a town or village green, it will so register the land.

Any person wishing to object to the registration of the land as a town or village green should send a statement of the facts upon which the representation is based to the Head of Legal and Democratic Services, Durham County Council, County Hall, Durham, DH1 5UL on or before Friday 12 October 2012. Any representations that are to be taken into account by the Authority in reaching a decision on the application cannot be treated as confidential and will be copied to the applicant for comment and may be disclosed to other interested parties.
