Notice of publication of Cotherstone Parish Neighbourhood Plan proposal under Regulation 16 of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 and the Localism Act 2011

The Submission draft of the Cotherstone Parish Neighbourhood Plan is being consulted upon between 21 September and 16<sup>th</sup> November 2021.

The Neighbourhood Plan sets down guidance for development within the Parish over the next 15 years. The Plan has been developed by the Parish Council incorporating feedback from residents, businesses and interested parties and from the review of a range of supporting documents. The plan includes policies on the Rural Setting of Cotherstone, Valued Green Spaces and Views, the Local Economy and Promoting Good Design.

The submission draft stage marks the final consultation before the plan will undergo examination by an independent examiner. If approved by the examiner, a referendum would then be held in the Parish to decide if it should be adopted as part of the statutory Development Plan for the area.

The submission consultation is run by Durham County Council. Comments are being invited on the Plan from **Tuesday 21st September 2021 to Tuesday 16th November 2021**.


