AssetPlus Screening Support Pack (Product Code: AP)

Interactive resource that has the screen questions rewritten into questions for the young person. Includes picture support, summary sheets and supporting booklet that outlines how to use the resources, what SLCN are, warning signs, strategies and when to make a referral to a Speech and Language Therapist.

(Product Code: YC)



The Youth Caution is written in language that is complex and legal.

Young people are asked to sign to state they understood the caution in the pressured environment of a Police Station. Young people and their parents/ carers can be supported through this process with this resource.

It includes three practice scenarios to introduce the concept and then asks the young person to reflect on their own situation. Ideal for assessments and offence analysis.



Thinking about victims

(Product Code: TAV-20 / TAV+20)




This is a speech language and friendly communication victim awareness programme. Young people that struggle with social imagination find empathy difficult. It is not easy to imagine being in the shoes of someone else.

This resource uses the thoughts and feelings of the victim in a concrete and structured way. It encourages the victim and young person to swap thoughts and feelings as they work through a parallel process. The resource naturally moves to shuttle mediation and prepares victims and young people for restorative meetings.

What's changed for the victim? (Product Code: WCV)



This is a resource to help record the voice of the victim.

Using communication friendly images, language and layout, it asks, what has changed for the victim since the offence? It focuses on their thoughts, feelings, and the impact of the offence.
