Stars Youth & Community – Youth / Family Drop In – Darren McMahon declared an interest.

3. Agreement of the Minutes – 6th September 2022 and matters arising not covered on this agenda:

The Minutes of 6th September were agreed as a true record. There were no matters arising.

4. Neighbourhood Issues and Locality Policing Issues:

Daniel asked if Board Members had any issues they would like to highlight at the meeting. There were no issues.

5. AAP Coordinator Update:

Daniel advised that a number of Community Recovery Area Budget applications had been received by the project call out deadline. He highlighted that the following applications had been brought to the Board for approval after being appraised by the panel:

Annfield Plain Community Centre – Warm Days

Daniel advised the Board that the outlay to date was £68,608. He asked for approval to go to another Call-Out. **The Board approved this.**

Nerise highlighted that if the closing date was after Christmas the results of the Stanley Fund applications would be known.

Community Engagement Review

Daniel advised that the Visioning Events were coming to an end and encouraged everyone to participate either at the events or by filling in the questionnaire before the 9th October deadline.

Helen McCaughey highlighted that she had asked for a complete copy of the final recommendations report once the review was finished.

Welfare Assistance Scheme for Stanley – Stanley AAP Funding Request

A discussion took place. Board Members felt that the budget should be extended as this fund would be needed over the Christmas holiday period. Daniel asked the Board for their opinion. It was suggested that the pot be increased **from £30k to £50K.**

The Board Approved the allocation.

South Moor Golf Club

Daniel highlighted that he had received a request for a letter of support for the relocation of South Moor Golf Club's Clubhouse, the redevelopment of the course and other works. A discussion took place. It was suggested that until a Pre-Planning application is submitted by the Club no letters of support would be sent.

Town & Villages

Daniel advised the next Town & Villages Task Group meeting would be held Monday 10th October, 2pm on 'Teams'. He highlighted that Graham Wood will be in attendance.

6. Partner Work Update / Stanley specific items of interest:

Karbon Homes – Suzanne advised that the Silver Talk Project was celebrating its 10-year anniversary this month.

Stanley Area Youth Consortium – Darren advised that the Youth Consortium's Fun & Food Project had been reviewed and 72% of the attendees were on free school meals, so the project was hitting the right people.

Stanley Town Council – Helen advised the Summer Events Programme had all gone well. Christmas Pantomime - Cinderella - Tickets are currently on sale Venue Hire - Helen advised that the Civic Hall had several rooms available to hire. Anyone wanting a quote to get in touch.

Neighbourhood Budgets

Tanfield Railway Trust – Tanfield Railway Brown Signs

The project will support the Trust to purchase five brown tourist signs that will guide visitors to the East Tanfield Station as visitors frequently arrive at Marley Hill site for booked train services, instead of East Tanfield Station resulting in them missing their allocated slot and having to rebook.
