




Account Set up, Login and Details

When you first access the system link you will need to create a 'Durham City Congestion Charge' account with your email address and a password of your choice.



On the next page you will then need to fill out your details including full name, contact number, and address. Then click Finish, this will then send an activation email to your email address which you must verify to enable you access to your account.






After verifying the email, you are now able to sign in. You will then be introduced to the main home screen page as below.



Creating Permit Applications

You will need to create a permit to enable you to purchase vouchers to access the area, by doing this you will need to select 'Permit application - Apply for a permit'.



You will be sent to the following screen where your permit category is automatically selected to then create the permit type.

Under Permit Type, you can see that we have inserted some help text to explain the issue period. In most cases this will be for 1 day, however if you do plan on making trips on consecutive days there is an option to select up to a 6 day period.

Under start date, please select the date that you will be using the road.


After you have selected the issue period and start date, you now can register the vehicle. You can have one vehicle registered per permit and you will see a registration box where you need to input your registration.

After you have input the vehicle registration, you will then notice a Questions box that you must acknowledge before proceeding. If you have any concerns about the question asked, please contact The Parking Shop on 0191 3846633.

Please review the permit application and click proceed. There will be a tick box for you to accept the Terms and Conditions, to read through them you can simply hover over the 'Terms and Conditions' text and this will enable you to click and be directed through to our website.












How to make Payment


After creating the permit application you will now be prompted to make the payment or add to your basket to pay later.

PLEASE NOTE: Payment must be made either prior to accessing the area or before midnight on the day of entry, if no payment is made by this time, you may receive a Penalty Charge Notice (PCN).



If you choose to add to basket, you will then see this available under the 'My Permit Applications' or via the shopping cart at the top of the screen, then you can either pay straight away or, if the access isn't required until a later date, payment may be made at any point before midnight on the date the road is used.


PLEASE NOTE: If you have multiple vehicles, you will need to create a permit application for each vehicle registration, however you can add them to basket to then pay the total balance by selecting 'Checkout and Pay' once you have inputted the registrations needed.






If you select 'Make Payment' you will be then transferred to this screen where you would need to make payment using a credit/debit card by entering the billing address and card details.





Once payment has been made, you will receive the following confirmation. This means that your permit application is now complete and you are able to access the Road User Charge area on the date(s) stated.
