The County Council of Durham (Public Right of Way Footpath Number 48, Crook) (Temporary Footpath Closure) Order 2023

The Council on 26/1/24 made the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Section 14(1) to prohibit all pedestrian traffic from proceeding on a 205 metre length of Public Footpath no.48 that extends north westerly from A689 High West Road, Crook to enable new housing development works to be undertaken. An alternative route will be available to pedestrian traffic from the south eastern side of the closure westerly along the associated footway of A689, then north-north easterly on a provided footpath that links to Footpath no.48 to the north western side of the closure, and vice versa. The maximum duration of the Order is 6 months. The proposed works are to commence on 7/2/24 and are anticipated to be required for 6 months. On occasions, alternative dates for closure may be necessary and these will be signed on site accordingly.
