The County Council of Durham (Haswell Plough Footbridge, Public Footpath No.7, Haswell Parish, Ludworth) (Temporary Footbridge & Public Footpath Closure) Order 2024

The Council on 3/1/2024 made the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Section 14(1) to prohibit all pedestrian traffic from proceeding on a 3 metre length of Footpath Number 7 Haswell Parish that crosses Haswell Plough Footbridge north of Ludworth to enable safeguard pedestrians until the footbridge is repaired or renewed. an alternative route available to pedestrian traffic from the northern side of the closure westerly via Footpath Number 20 Haswell Parish and turning southerly onto Footpath Number 5 Haswell Parish onto Footpath Number 24 Shadforth Parish and easterly onto Footpath Number 23 Haswell Parish onto Footpath Number 25 leading to southern side of the closure and vice versa. The maximum duration of the Order is 6 months and the closure is anticipated to be required for the full duration. On occasions, alternative dates for closure may be necessary and these will be signed on site accordingly.
