The County Council of Durham (C37 Linden Road, Ferryhill) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2024

The Council on 16/2/24 made the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Section 14(1) to prohibit all vehicular traffic from proceeding on a 19 metre length of the C37 Linden Road, Ferryhill from its junction with Lambton Road at eastern side of closure in a westerly direction to the front of Lynton & no.1 Lindon Road to enable sewer repair works to be undertaken. Throughout the period of closure, a diversion will be available to vehicular traffic from east side of closure in an easterly direction on Linden Road, then south on Duncombe Bank, then west on C26 Gladstone Terrace to western end of closure and vice versa. The maximum duration of the Order is 18 months. The proposed works are to commence from 8am on 26/2/24 and are anticipated to be completed in 10 days. On occasions, alternative dates for closure may be necessary and these will be signed on site accordingly.
