Relevant speed restrictions, road closures and alternative routes will be clearly signed to vehicular traffic, where appropriate. The maximum duration of the Order is 18 months. The proposed works are to commence on 1/3/24 and during the anticipated programme of around 7 months. On occasions, alternative dates for closure may be necessary and these will be signed accordingly.
