

The County Council of Durham
(Public Right of Way Footpath Number 33 off Pelton Fell Road, Chester-le-
Street) (Temporary Footpath Closure)
Order 2024

The Council on 7/2/24 made the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Section 14(1) to prohibit all pedestrian traffic from proceeding on a 178 metre length of PROW Footpath Number 33 that extends easterly from its junction with Pelton Fell Road, Chester le Street to enable full investigation and repair works to be undertaken. An alternative route will be available to pedestrian traffic from the western side of the closure easterly via the associated footway of Pelton Fell Road toward Market Place and to the North Burns footpath leading to the eastern side of the closure and vice versa. The maximum duration of the Order is 6 months. The Closure order is required from 9/2/24 for up to the maximum period of 6 months or until the land slip is stabilised and the path safe to re-open, whichever is the sooner. On occasions, alternative dates for closure may be necessary and these will be signed on site accordingly.
