

The County Council of Durham
(B1404 Seaton Lane, Seaton, Seaham)
(Temporary Weight Limit Suspension)
Order 2024

The Council on 23.2.24 made the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Section 14(1) to de-restrict all vehicular traffic on the B1404 Seaton Lane for 43 metres, (immediately west of the A19 Northbound on-slip) to enable new roundabout construction and tie-in works to be undertaken. It has therefore been necessary to temporarily suspend that part of The County Council of Durham (Various Locations)(Easington District Coxhoe and Durham City)(Weight Restrictions) Order 2006. An alternative route will be available to vehicular traffic during the A19 southbound off-slip to Seaton Lane closure from the northern side of closure from A19 Doxford Park/Herrington Interchange south westerly on A690 to Houghton-le-Spring, southerly onto A182 then easterly on B1404 toward Seaham. The maximum duration of the Order is 18 months. The proposed works are to commence on 6.3.24 and are anticipated to be completed in 17 weeks. On occasions, alternative dates for suspension may be necessary and these will be signed on site accordingly.
