## The County Council of Durham (Footpath No 24 Monk Hesleden Parish, Hesleden) (Temporary Footpath Closure) Order 2024

The Council on 24/4/2024 made the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 as amended, Section 14 (1) to prohibit all pedestrian traffic from proceeding on a 230 metre length of Footpath No 24 that extends southwards from the Haswell-Hart Countryside Walkway, Hesleden to enable former pit heap reclamation works or site reinstatement works (depending upon planning decision) to be undertaken. An alternative route will not be available to pedestrian traffic during the closure period. The maximum duration of the Order is 6 months. The order will commence on 7/5/2024 and be required for a period of up to 6 months. On occasions, alternative dates for closure may be necessary and these will be signed accordingly. This order supersedes The County Council of Durham (Footpath No.24 Monk Hesleden Parish, Hesleden) (Temporary Footpath Closure) Order 2022
