The County Council of Durham (Public Byway No.12 Sedgefield Parish, Yarm Lane, Sedgefield) (Temporary Byway Closure) Order 2024

The Council on 10/5/2024 made the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 as amended, Section 14(1) to prohibit all vehicular and horse drawn traffic from proceeding on a 3.3 kilometre length of Byway Number 12, also known as Yarm Lane, that extends southwards from Neasless Farm, Sedgefield to enable resettlement to occur following recent repair works. An alternative route will be available to vehicular and horse drawn traffic from the northern side of the closure from A177 south westwards on Stockton Road then westerly toward Thorpe Leazes and Whitton to the southern side of the closure, and vice versa. The maximum duration of the Order is 6 months. The proposed works are to commence on 15/5/2024 and are anticipated to be completed in 6 months. On occasions, alternative dates for closure may be necessary and these will be signed accordingly.
