3. Nomination papers must be delivered to the (Acting) Returning Officer, at County Hall, Durham, DH1 5UL on any day after the date of this notice, Monday to Friday 10am to 4pm (excluding bank holidays) but no later than 4 pm on Friday, 7th June 2024.

 8. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate or an Anonymous Elector's Document valid for this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5 pm on Wednesday, 26th June 2024.
