

The County Council of Durham
(A690 Gilesgate Roundabout and Claypath, Durham)
(Temporary Footway Closure, Prohibition of Driving and Prohibition of Right Turn) Order 2024

The Council on 14/6/2024 made the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 as amended, Section 14 (1) to prohibit and restrict all vehicular and pedestrian traffic from proceeding on the following lengths of road in the manner described **Footway Closure** prohibit pedestrian traffic from proceeding on **1.** a 100 metre length of associated footway of A690 Gilesgate roundabout from the junction with A690 Leazes Road northerly and westerly onto Claypath (southern footway) **2.**a 30 metre length of northern footway of Claypath outside the surgery as depicted on site by appropriate signage. **Prohibition of Driving 1.**Prohibit any vehicular traffic from driving in a westerly direction on a 75 metre length of Claypath that extends from its junction with A690 Gilesgate Roundabout. **Prohibition of Right Turn 2.**Prohibit and vehicular traffic from Turning right from Leazes Lane onto Claypath to enable cycleway and retaining wall works to be undertaken. An alternative route will be available to vehicular traffic from the eastern side of the closure from Gilesgate Roundabout westerly on A690, turning onto Walkergate leading to Freemans Place and southerly on Providence Row to Claypath to the western side of the closure. Pedestrians will be diverted onto opposite footways in the Gilesgate Roundabout area. The maximum duration of the Order is 18 months. The proposed works are to commence on 17/6/2024 and are anticipated to be completed in 5 to 6 weeks. On occasions, alternative dates for closure may be necessary and these will be signed accordingly.
