The County Council of Durham (Unc 12.27 Beamishburn Road, Badgers Wood and Robert Terrace, Stanley)(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2024

The Council on 21/6/2024 made the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 as amended, Section 14 (1) to prohibit all vehicular traffic from proceeding on the following lengths of road: Unc 12.27 Beamishburn Road a 208 metres length approx. 62 metre north east from Cherry Tree Cottage to the junction with Badgers Wood. Badgers Wood a 53 metre length from the junction with Beamishburn Road and the front of No.34 Badgers Wood and Robert Terrace an 8 metre length from the junction with the A6076 extending south eastwards for approx. 8 metres to enable gas main replacement works to be undertaken. Throughout the period of closure, a diversion to vehicular traffic for Unc 12.27 Beamishburn Road and Badgers Wood will be available from the southern end of the closure north on A6076 Causey Road then south on Unc 12.27 Beamishburn Road to northern end of closure and vice versa. A diversion for Roberts Terrace will be available via Sylvia Terrace. The maximum duration of the Order is 18 months. The proposed works are to be carried out by a rolling closure and will commence from 8am on Monday 1/7/2024 and are anticipated to be completed in 5 weeks. On occasions, alternative dates for closure may be necessary and these will be signed accordingly.
