The County Council of Durham (Whitehouse Lane (West Back), Ushaw Moor) (Temporary Footpath Closure) Order 2024

The Council on 21/6/2024 made the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 as amended, Section 14 (1) to prohibit all pedestrian traffic from proceeding on a 45 metre length of Whitehouse Lane (West Back), Ushaw Moor to the side of No. 1 Whitehouse Lane and rear of No's 1 to 4 Whitehouse Lane to enable new electric connection works to be undertaken. Throughout the period of closure, a diversion will be available to pedestrian traffic from east side of closure in a southerly direction on B6302 Broom Lane then west on B6302 Cockhouse Lane then north on Ushaw Terrace to Cockhouse Lane then east on Ushaw Terrace to Whitehouse Lane West Back to western end of closure and vice versa. The maximum duration of the Order is 6 months. The proposed works are to commence from 8am on Tuesday 2/7/2024 and are anticipated to be completed in 14 days. On occasions, alternative dates for closure may be necessary and these will be signed accordingly.
