The County Council of Durham (Unclassified road 116.9 Chapel Lane / Cowclose Lane, Scargill) (Temporary Road closure) Order 2024

The Council on 19/6/2024 made the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 as amended, Section 14 (1) to prohibit all vehicular traffic from proceeding on a 4.29 kilometre length of road known as Chapel Lane and Cowclose Lane that extends between its junction with C166 Stang Lane and Public Byway Number 5, Low Lane, Scargill Barningham to enable collapsed parapet wall rebuilding works to be undertaken. An alternative route will be available to vehicular traffic from the western side of the closure from C166 Stang Lane northerly to A66 then easterly on A66 and turning south onto C167 to Greta Bridge to Barningham then westerly onto Cowclose Lane to the eastern side of the closure, and vice versa. Resident access will be afforded from either side up to the bridge. The maximum duration of the Order is 18 months. The proposed works are to commence on Monday 1/7/2024, daily between 7.30am and 3.30pm with no works over the weekend, works are anticipated to be completed in 6 working days. On occasions, alternative dates for closure may be necessary and these will be signed accordingly.
