

The County Council of Durham
(C31 Crakehill Bank leading to Saunders Avenue, Hamsterley)
(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2024

The Council on 26/6/2024 made the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 as amended, Section 14 (1) to prohibit all vehicular traffic from proceeding on a 675 metre length of road C31 Crakehill Bank that extends westward from its junction with A68 Witton le Wear toward Saunders Avenue, Hamsterley to enable an essential groundwork investigation and repair scheme to be completed following land slippage. An alternative route will be available to vehicular traffic from the eastern side of the closure from A68 southerly to the junction with road C33 Diddridge Lane and turning north onto C30 Daniel Lane toward Hamsterley and the junction with road C31 to the western side of the closure, and vice versa. The maximum duration of the Order is 18 months. The order will commence on 9/7/2024 and will be required until the end of 2025. On occasions, alternative dates for closure may be necessary and these will be signed accordingly.
