Statement of Reasons

Durham County Council as Highway Authority propose to make the above order in discharge of its duty under Section 122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, "to secure the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of vehicular and other traffic (including pedestrians)", in accordance with the provisions of Section 1(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 namely:-

(a)	for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising, or	\checkmark
(b)	for preventing damage to the road or to any building on or near the road, or	
(c)	for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians), or	\checkmark
(d)	for preventing the use of the road by vehicular traffic of a kind which, or its use by vehicular traffic in a manner which, is unsuitable having regard to the existing character of the road or adjoining property, or	
(e)	(without prejudice to the generality of paragraph(d) above) for preserving the character of the road in a case where it is specially suitable for use by persons on horseback or on foot, or	
(f)	for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs; or	
(g)	For any of the purposes specified in paragraphs (a) to (c) of subsection (1) of section 87 of the Environment Act 1995 (air quality).

Purpose of Amendments

The following brief synopsis of amendments should be viewed in conjunction with the plans identified within the Schedules to the above Order however the plans should prevail in the event of any discrepancy:

To Introduce No Waiting and No Loading At Any Time Restrictions on:-

- **a.B1278 Salters Lane** on its western side, from a point 20 metres north of its crossroads with Front Street and Butterwick Road, in a northerly direction for a distance of 5.4 metres plan EQ101 refers.
- **b.B1278 Salters Lane** on its eastern side, from a point 20 metres north of its crossroads with Front Street and Butterwick Road, in a northerly direction for a distance of 42 metres, leading around its junction with East View plan EQ101 refers.
- **c.East View** on its southern side, from a point 14 metres west of its junction with Park View, in a westerly direction for a distance of 4 metres, leading around its junction with B1287 Salters Lane plan EQ101 refers.
- **d.East View** on its northern side, from a point 14 metres west of its junction with Park View, in a westerly direction for a distance of 5 metres, leading to its junction with B1287 Salters Lane plan EQ101 refers.

3.SCHEDULES

The following amendments to the Schedule(s) have been made:

Plan EQ101 has been amended to reflect the changes to those restrictions noted in Article 2 above Where the plans are referenced in the Schedules to the Order described in Article 2 above, new plans bearing the seal date as at the date of this Amendment Order have been inserted.

4. Saving

In so for as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision which is contained in an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment then the provisions of this Order shall prevail.

The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
