## The County Council of Durham (C4 Baytree Terrace, High Handenhold) (Temporary Road) Order 2024

The Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 as amended, Section 14 (1) to prohibit all motor vehicular traffic from proceeding on a 470 metre length of C4 from Baytree Terrace extending north to the junction with Stony Lane, High Handenhold, Beamish to enable ramp access upgrade works to be undertaken. A signed alternative route will be available to vehicular traffic from the southern side of the closure from C4/C84 south onto A693 then easterly to Perkinsville, north on C5 Ouston Lane, north west on St Benets Way, south westerly on C85 to High Urpeth onto C4 leading to Stony Lane to the northern side of the closure, and vice versa. The maximum duration of the Order is 18 months. The proposed works are to commence on Monday 15/7/2024 and are anticipated to be completed in 4 weeks. On occasions, alternative dates for closure may be necessary and these will be signed accordingly.
