## The County Council of Durham (Public Rights of Way Footpath No.136 (Wolsingham Parish) Harperley Park Footbridge, Fir Tree) Temporary Footpath Closure) Order 2023

The above-named Order made by the Council on 30/6/2023, under section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and which became operational on 30/06/2023 has been continued in force from 30/6/2024, as approved by the Secretary of State for Transport, until 30/6/2025 or until completion of the works, whichever is the earlier. The effect of the Order is to temporarily close to all pedestrian traffic a 1301 metre length of Public Rights of Way Footpath No.136 (Wolsingham Parish) near Harperley Park Footbridge, Fir Tree between Public Rights of Way No.137 near New Plantation and Public Rights of Way No.138 near Wadley to enable footbridge repair works to be undertaken. Throughout the period of closure, a diversion will be available to pedestrian traffic from west side of closure in an easterly direction on Public Rights of Way No.137 then in a south easterly direction on A68 Fir Tree, then onto Public Rights of Way Footpath No.139 in a southerly direction to western end of closure and vice versa.
