

The County Council of Durham
(West Lane / Waldrige Road, Chester le Street)
(Temporary Road and Footway Closure) Order 2024

The Council on 10/7/2024 made the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 as amended, Section 14 (1) to prohibit all vehicular and pedestrian traffic from proceeding on the following lengths of road and footway:- **Road Closure** a 277 metre length of West Lane-Waldrige Road between its junctions with Wilfred Street and Blencathra Way, and incorporating a 55 metre length of South Approach, Chester le Street. **Footway Closure** the footway link from Vivian Crescent toward the ramp leading to Gibbs Court to enable carriageway resurfacing works to be undertaken. An alternative route will be available to vehicular traffic from the eastern side of the closure from West Lane easterly along Ropery Lane, north on A167, south westerly on Picktree Lane, westerly on North Burns and Pelton Fell Road, turning south onto North Approach to the junction with The Avenue or following the orbital road of Whitehill Way to Waldrige Road to the western side of the closure, and vice versa. Pedestrians will be diverted from South Approach westerly on Waldrige Road and crossing south at the Blencathra Way junction then easterly under the pedestrian walkway at the rail bridge, and vice versa. The maximum duration of the Order is 18 months. The proposed works are to commence from 7am on Monday 22/7/24 and are anticipated to be completed in 5 days (between 7am and 7pm per day). On occasions, alternative dates for closure may be necessary and these will be signed accordingly.
