## The County Council of Durham (Durham City Footpath No 83, Pelaw Leazes (North Span) Footbridge, Durham) (Temporary Footpath Closure) Order 2024

The Council on 26/7/2024 made the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 as amended, Section 14 (1) to prohibit all pedestrian traffic from proceeding on up to a 175 metre length of Public Footpath No.83 Durham City Parish that extends southwards from St Giles Close over Pelaw Leazes (North Span) Footbridge to its junction with Footpath No's 84 & 85 Pelaw Woods Durham to enable footbridge deck refurbishment works to be undertaken. An alternative route will be available to pedestrian traffic from the northern side of the closure from St Giles Close westerly on Footpath No.107 to St Giles Church then northerly on Footpath No.105 to Gilesgate then westerly to on Gilesgate and south on St Hilds Lane and continuing on Footpath No.106, easterly on Footpath No.78 over Pelaw Wood Beck Footbridge and north easterly on Footpath No.85 to the southern side of the closure, and vice versa. The maximum duration of the Order is 6 months. The proposed works are to commence on Monday 5/8/2024 and are anticipated to be completed in 29 days. On occasions, alternative dates for closure may be necessary and these will be signed accordingly.
