The County Council of Durham (East Parade Footbridge crossing A692 Rotary Way, Consett) (Temporary Footbridge Closure) Order 2024

The Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 as amended, Section 14 (1) to prohibit all pedestrian traffic from proceeding on East Parade Footbridge and its approaches from Gill Street and East Parade/Railway Street, Consett to enable bridge deck waterproofing and surfacing works to be undertaken. An alternative route will be available to pedestrian traffic from the southern side of the closure from Gill Street easterly and crossing Delves Lane then north to A692 and crossing to the northern side of A692 then crossing B6308 westerly to East Parade leading to the northern side of the closure, and vice versa. The maximum duration of the Order is 6 months. The proposed works are to commence on Monday 12/8/2024 and are anticipated to be completed in 5 days. On occasions, alternative dates for closure may be necessary and these will be signed accordingly.
