The County Council of Durham (Station Approach to Tenter Terrace Footbridge, Durham City) (Temporary Footbridge Closure) Order 2024

The Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 as amended, Section 14 (1) to prohibit all pedestrian traffic from proceeding on a 70 metre length of Station Approach Footbridge between its junctions with Station Approach and Tenter Terrace/A690, Durham to enable footbridge and stepped access resurfacing works to be undertaken. An alternative route will be available to pedestrian traffic from the northern side of the closure from Station Approach westerly to North Road then south easterly to A690 and the crossing point leading to Tenter Terrace to the southern side of the closure, and vice versa. The maximum duration of the Order is 6 months. The proposed works are to commence on Wednesday 14/8/2024 and are anticipated to be completed in 10 days. On occasions, alternative dates for closure may be necessary and these will be signed accordingly.
