## The County Council of Durham (Leazes Footbridge, Durham City) (Temporary Footpath Closure) Order 2023

The above-named Order made by the Council on 4/8/23, under section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and which became operational on 7/8/23 then subsequently extended to 7/8/24 has been continued in force from 8/8/2024, as approved by the Secretary of State for Transport, until 9/11/2024 or until completion of the works, whichever is the earlier. The effect of the Order is to temporarily prohibit all pedestrian traffic from proceeding on a 57 metre length of Leazes Footbridge, Durham City which crosses the A690 Leazes Road, Durham City to enable footbridge demolition works to be undertaken. Throughout the period of closure, a diversion will be available from north side of closure in an easterly direction on Gilesgate then in a south easterly direction crossing the A690 then Station Lane and Gilesgate Bank then south westerly on Leazes Road to southern end of closure and vice versa.
