The Sills on the eastern side from an adjacent point 15m south of its junction with Gill Lane in a northern direction for a distance of 43m m.The Sills on the eastern side from an adjacent point 90m north of its junction with Gill Lane in a northern direction for a distance of 15m n.Ullathorne Rise on the northern side into the junction with The Sills in a northern direction for a distance of 51m o.Ullathorne Rise on the southern side into the junction with The Sills in a South-easterly direction for a distance of 14m. To Introduce Disabled Badge Holders Only Bays on:- Baliol Street on the northeastern side from a point 4m northwest of its junction with Galgate in north-westerly for a distance of 13m a total of two bays. All other restrictions locally remain the same. Statement of Reasons

Durham County Council as Highway Authority propose to make the above order in discharge of its duty under Section 122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, "to secure the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of vehicular and other traffic (including pedestrians)", in accordance with the provisions of Section 1(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 namely:-

The County Council of Durham ("the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32 & 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended ("the Act") and Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. General

This Order may be cited as The County Council of Durham (Barnard Castle) (Prohibition Of Waiting & Stopping, Restriction Of Waiting, Loading/Unloading & Parking Places) Order 2011 (Amendment No. 1) Order 2024 and shall come into operation on the day of .

2. Amendments

The under-noted amendments have been made to The County Council of Durham (Barnard Castle) (Prohibition of Waiting & Stopping, Restriction of Waiting, Loading/Unloading & Parking Places) Order 2011.

Purpose of Amendments

The following brief synopsis of amendments should be viewed in conjunction with the plans identified within the Schedules to the above Order, however the plan(s) should prevail in the event of any discrepancy:

To introduce No Waiting At any Time restrictions on:

- **a.Flatts Road** on the northern side of its junction with Galgate in a north westerly direction continuing from the existing waiting restriction for a distance of 9 metres (Plan CE44 refers).
- **b.Vere Road** on the southern side into the junction with Commercial Yard in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 12 metres (Plan CE44 refers).
- **c.Vere Road** on the southern side into the junction with Commercial Yard in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 12 metres (Plan CE44 refers).
- **d.Newgate** on the northern side into the junction with Hepworth's Yard in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 5 metres (Plan CF42 refers).
- **e.Newgate** on the northern side into the junction with Hepworth's Yard in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 5 metres (Plan CF42 refers).
- **f.Newgate** on the northern side into the junction with North View in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 5 metres (Plan CF42 refers).
- **g.Newgate** on the northern side into the junction with North View in a North-westerly direction for a distance of 5 metres.(Plan CF42 refers).
- **h.Newgate** on the northern side into the junction with Wood Street in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 5 metres (Plan CF42 refers).
- i.Newgate on the northern side into the junction with Wood Street in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 5 metres (Plan CF42 refers).
- **j.Gill Lane** on the northern side into the junction with The Sills in a northern direction for a distance of 28 metres (Plan CE42 refers).

k.Gill Lane – on the southern side from its junction with The Sills in a southern direction for a distance of 28 metres (Plan CE42 refers).

I.The Sills – on the eastern side from an adjacent point 15 metres south of its junction with Gill Lane in a northern direction for a distance of 43 metres (Plan CE42 refers).

m.The Sills – on the eastern side from an adjacent point 90 metres north of its junction with Gill Lane in a northern direction for a distance of 15 metres (Plan CE42 refers).

n.Ullathorne Rise – on the northern side into the junction with The Sills in a northern direction for a distance of 51 metres (Plans CE42 & CE43 refer).

o.Ullathorne Rise – on the southern side into the junction with The Sills in a South-easterly direction for a distance of 14 metres. (Plan CE42 refers).

To Introduce Disabled Badge Holders Only Bays on:-

Baliol Street – on the northeastern side from a point 4 metres northwest of its junction with Galgate in north-westerly for a distance of 13 metres (two bays) (Plan CF44 refers).

3.Schedules:

Plans CF44, CE42, CE43, CE44, EF42 have been amended to reflect the changes to those restrictions noted in Article 2 above. Where these plans are referenced in the Schedules to the Order described in Article 2 above, new plans bearing the seal date as at the date of this Amendment Order have been inserted.


4.Saving


