The County Council of Durham ("the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32 & 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended ("the Act") and Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1.General

This Order may be cited as The County Council of Durham (Crook) (Parking and Waiting Restrictions) (Consolidation Order No.1) 2021 (Amendment No. 1) Order 2024 and shall come into operation on the day of 20

2.Amendments

The under-noted amendments have been made to the following Order:

The County Council of Durham (Crook) (Parking and Waiting Restrictions) Order 2012.

Purpose of Amendments

The following brief synopsis of amendments should be viewed in conjunction with the plans identified within the Schedules to the above Order, however the plan(s) should prevail in the event of any discrepancy:

To introduce 'No Waiting At Any Time restrictions on:

a.on the northern side of north Billy Row Green from a point adjacent to Number 3 Billy Row Green in a north westerly direction for a distance of 21 metres - plan DB120 refers.

b.on the southern side of north Billy Row Green from a point opposite Number 3 Billy Row Green in a north westerly direction for a distance of 13 metres - plan DB120 refers.

c.on the northern side of south Billy Row Green from a point adjacent to the beginning of the footpath in a north westerly direction for a distance of 15 metres - plan DB119 refers.

d.on the southern side of south Billy Row Green from a point adjacent to the dropped access in a westerly direction for a distance of 11 metres - plan DB119 refers.

To introduce a 'Loading only 9am – 12pm' bay on:

On the eastern side of Mill Street, Crook from a point adjacent to Number 2 Mill Street travelling in a northerly direction for a distance of 5 metres - Plan DC113 refers.

4.Schedules:

Plans DB119, DB120, DC113 have been amended to reflect the changes to those restrictions noted in Article 2 above. Where these plans are referenced in the Schedules to the Order described in Article 2 above, new plans bearing the seal date as at the date of this Amendment Order have been inserted.

5.Saving

In so far as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision which is contained in an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment then the provisions of this Order shall prevail.

The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
