The County Council of Durham (Newcomen Street, Ferryhill) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2024

The Council on 16/8/2024 made the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 as amended, Section 14 (1) to prohibit all vehicular traffic from proceeding on a 16 metre length of Newcomen Street, Ferryhill from junction with B6287 Merrington Road at southern side of closure in a northerly direction to the front of no. 12 Newcomen Street to enable gas main replacement works to be undertaken. Throughout the period of closure, a diversion will be available to vehicular traffic from south side of closure in a westerly direction on B6287 Merrington Road then north on Kelvin Street then east on Watt Street then south on Newcomen Street to northern end of closure and vice versa. The maximum duration of the Order is 18 months. The proposed works are to commence from 8am on Tuesday 27/08/2024 and are anticipated to be completed in 15 days. On occasions, alternative dates for closure may be necessary and these will be signed accordingly.
