

The County Council of Durham
(Unsworth Street, Unsworth Gardens and Kelvin Gardens, Consett)
(Temporary Road and Footpath Closure) Order 2024

The Council on 16/8/2024 made the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 as amended, Section 14 (1) to prohibit all vehicular and pedestrian traffic from proceeding on the following lengths of road and footpath; **Road Closure (vehicular traffic)** a 22 metre length of Unsworth Street from junction with Palmerston Street to junction with Unsworth Gardens and a 42 metre length of Unsworth Gardens to the rear of no. 1 to 8 Unsworth Gardens. **Footpath Closure (pedestrian traffic)** a 65 metres length of Kelvin Gardens between 1 to 23 and 2 to 20 Kelvin Gardens to enable gas main replacement works to be undertaken. Throughout the period of closure, a diversion will be available to vehicular traffic from the north side of the closure in an easterly direction on Palmerston Street then south on Roseberry Terrace and then west on Railway Street to southern end of closure and vice versa. An alternative route for pedestrian traffic will be on the surrounding footpaths of Kelvin Gardens. The maximum duration of the Order is 6 months. The proposed works are to commence from 8am on Thursday 22/8/2024 and are anticipated to be completed in 4 weeks. On occasions, alternative dates for closure may be necessary and these will be signed accordingly.
