The County Council of Durham (Cut Street, Ferryhill) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2024

The Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 as amended, Section 14 (1) to prohibit all vehicular traffic from proceeding on a 21 metres length of Cut Street, Ferryhill from the junction with B6287 Merrington Road at the southern side of closure in a northerly direction to the junction with St Cuthberts Terrace/Newton Street (Rear) to enable gas main replacement works to be undertaken. Throughout the period of closure, a diversion will be available to vehicular traffic from the south side of the closure in a westerly direction on B6287 Merrington Road then north on Newcomen Street then east on Davy Street (Rear) then south on Cut Street to the northern end of closure and vice versa. The maximum duration of the Order is 18 months. The proposed works are to commence at 8am on 2/9/2024 and are anticipated to be completed in 15 days. On occasions, alternative dates for closure may be necessary and these will be signed accordingly.
