The County Council of Durham (Public Rights of Way Footpath No.14 (Ashes Quarry No.1 & No.2 Footbridges) Stanhope) (Temporary Footpath Closure) Order 2024

The Council on 16/8/2024 made the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 as amended, Section 14 (1) to prohibit all pedestrian traffic from proceeding on a 460 metre length of footpath No.14 Stanhope parish that extends between footpaths No's 14a and 76a (north of Dunsfield Farm Estate), and footpath No.16 (south east of Prospect House), Stanhope to safeguard members of the public using the route. The alternative route for pedestrian traffic is from the south eastern side of the closure from footpath No.14 north westerly on footpath No.76a and continuing on footpath No.76 and 71 to road B6278 then northerly on Crawleyside Bank to the junction with footpath No.14 (adjacent to Field Row) leading to the north western side of the closure and vice versa. The maximum duration of the Order is 6 months. The Order will come into force on 16/8/2024 is required for a period of up to 6 months. On occasions, alternative dates for closure may be necessary and these will be signed accordingly.
