

The County Council of Durham
(Public Rights of Way Footpaths Number 56 & 57 Spennymoor Parish)
(Temporary Footpath Closure)
Order 2024

The Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 as amended, Section 14 (1) to prohibit all pedestrian traffic from proceeding on a 297 metre length of Footpath 56 from approximately 20 metres north of its access with the B6288 Vyners Close at southern side of closure in a northerly direction to junction with Footpath 57 and a 144 metre length of Footpath 57 from its junction with Footpath 56 at western side of closure in an easterly direction to the rear of the Jubilee Centre to enable gas main replacement works to be undertaken. Throughout the period of closure, a diversion will be available to pedestrian traffic via grass mats provided by the contractor. The maximum duration of the Order is 6 months. The proposed works are to commence on 2/9/2024 and are anticipated to be completed in 5 weeks. On occasions, alternative dates for closure may be necessary and these will be signed accordingly.
