The County Council of Durham (The A689 and The Cottages, Rushyford) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2024

The Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 as amended, Section 14 (1) to prohibit all vehicular traffic from proceeding on an 83-metre length of A689 between the circulatory carriageways of A689/A167 Rushyford Roundabout and A688/C35 Roundabout and also the access road to The Cottages (adjacent to the Eden Arms Hotel), Rushyford to enable carriageway resurfacing works to be undertaken. An alternative route will be available to vehicular traffic from the eastern side of the closure from Rushyford Roundabout, north on A167 north to Thinford Roundabout then south westerly on A688 to Canney Hill Roundabout the east on A689 to C35 Roundabout leading to Woodham to the western side of the closure, and vice versa. The maximum duration of the Order is 18 months. The proposed works are to commence on 4/9/2024 between 7pm and 7am and are anticipated to be completed in 2 weeks. On occasions, alternative dates for closure may be necessary and these will be signed accordingly.
