## The County Council of Durham (A688 Roman Road, Barnard Castle) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2024

The Council on 4/9/2024 made the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act. 1984 as amended. Section 14 (1) to prohibit all vehicular traffic from proceeding on a 699 metre length of the A688 Roman Road, Barnard Castle from approximately 100 metres north east of the junction with Barnard Castle Shopping Park at north western side of closure in a north easterly direction to the junction with Unc 46.5 Town Pasture Lane to enable Tees Pipeline installation works to be undertaken. Throughout the period of closure, a diversion will be available to vehicular traffic from north eastern side of closure in a north westerly direction on A688 Roman Road, then east on A67 Darlington Road then south on Carmel Road South then north on A167 Grange Road then east on Victoria Road then north on A167 St Cuthberts Way then west on A68 St Augustines Way/Bondgate then north/north west on A68 West Auckland Road then west on A688 then south west on A688 West Auckland/Evenwood Gate/Staindrop to northern end of closure and vice versa. The maximum duration of the Order is 18 months. The proposed works are to commence at 7am on 13/9/2024 and are anticipated to be completed in 4 Days. On occasions, alternative dates for closure may be necessary and these will be signed accordingly.
