The County Council of Durham (C12 Dryburn View and Finchale Road, Durham) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2024

The Council proposes to make an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, to prohibit all vehicular traffic from proceeding on a 430 metre length of Dryburn View and Finchale Road that extends easterly from its junction with St Cuthberts Avenue, and also a 100 metre length of High Carr Road that extends southwards from the Bus Gate junction with Front Street, Framwellgate Moor. Closures will be phased to maintain access as far as possible for residents. It will also be necessary to temporarily suspend the No Entry restriction from High Carr Road into Durham Moor Crescent for resident access, as detailed in the County Council of Durham (Durham Moor Crescent, Framwellgate Moor)(Prohibition of Entry) Order 1973 to enable carriageway resurfacing works to be undertaken. An alternative route will be available to vehicular traffic from A. The Western side of the closure from St Cuthberts Avenue South westerly to the roundabout then south easterly along Dryburn Road and north on High Carr Road to the eastern side of the closure; B. The South western side of the closure from Avkley Heads Roundabout north westerly on Dryburn Road, then north easterly to the northern side of the closure / and continuing northerly on Framwellgate Moor Font Street, easterly along Abbey Road then southerly / south westerly onto Pit Lane to the north eastern side of the closure and vice versa. The maximum duration of the Order is 18 months. The proposed works are to commence from 7pm on 10/10/2024 and anticipated to be completed in 10 nights to around midnight each night. On occasions, alternative dates for closure may be necessary and these will be signed accordingly.
