## The County Council of Durham (A167 Park Road South, Chester le Street) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2024

The Council on 20/9/2024 made the above Order which was effective from 29/9/2024 under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, to prohibit all vehicular traffic from proceeding on a 775 metre length of the northbound dual carriageway of A167 Park Road South from its junction with the crossover to Holmhill Lane to its junction with Hermitage Roundabout, Chester le Street to enable carriageway resurfacing and gulley renewal works to be undertaken. An alternative route will be signed to vehicular traffic from the southern side of the closure, from A167 Sniperley Roundabout on A691 westerly to Lanchester, then north on A6076 to Annfield Plain, then north easterly and easterly on A693 to Northlands Roundabout and junction with B6313 Park Road North leading to A167, to the northern side of the closure. The maximum duration of the Order is 18 months. The proposed works, that were due to commence on 29/9/2024, will now commence on Sunday 3/11/2024 (daily between 7pm and 6am) and are anticipated to be completed in 6 nights. On occasions, alternative dates for closure may be necessary and these will be signed accordingly.
