The Council intend to make an Order under Sections 1, 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will prohibit all vehicles (including pedal cycles) from proceeding in the following manner **Prohibtion of Right Turn:**- from making a right-hand turn from the north bound carriageway of the A691 Framwellgate Peth into The Gardens, Millburngate and from The Gardens Millburngate onto the northbound A691 Framwellgate Peth. **No Entry:**- entering The Gardens, Millburngate via the left hand exit road from the A691 Framwellgate Peth. # **Statement of Reasons**

Durham County Council as Highway Authority propose to make the above order in discharge of its duty under Section 122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, "to secure the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of vehicular and other traffic (including pedestrians)", in accordance with the provisions of Section 1(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 namely:-

(a)	for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising, or	$\checkmark$
(b)	for preventing damage to the road or to any building on or near the road, or	
(c)	for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians), or	$\checkmark$
(d)	for preventing the use of the road by vehicular traffic of a kind which, or its use by vehicular traffic in a manner which, is unsuitable having regard to the existing character of the road or adjoining property, or	
(e)	(without prejudice to the generality of paragraph(d) above) for preserving the character of the road in a case where it is specially suitable for use by persons on horseback or on foot, or	
(f)	for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs; or	
(g)	For any of the purposes specified in paragraphs (a) to (c) of subsection (1) of section 87 of the Environment Act 1995 (air quality).

# THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF DURHAM (A691 FRAMWELLGATE PETH & THE GARDENS, MILLBURNGATE) (PROHIBITION OF RIGHT TURNS & NO ENTRY) ORDER 2024

The County Council of Durham ("the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2 and 4 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

#### Part I

#### 1.General

This Order may be cited as The County Council of Durham (A691 Framwellgate Peth & The Gardens, Millburngate) (Prohibition of Right Turns & No Entry) Order 2024 and shall come into operation on day of 2024.

#### 2.Interpretation

In this Order the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:-

"enforcement officer" means a uniformed police officer, police community support officer or any subsequent designation of these officers;

"pedal cycle" means a pedal cycle or pedal tricycle, not being in either case a motor vehicle.

#### Part II

#### 3. Prohibition of Right Turn

Save as provided in Article 5 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of an enforcement officer, cause or permit any vehicle (including pedal cycles) to make a right turn from the roads specified in Column 1 of the Schedule 1 to this Order onto the roads specified in Column 2 of the said Schedule 1.

#### 4. No Entry

Save as provided in Article 5 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of an enforcement officer cause or permit any vehicle, including pedal cycles, to enter the road specified in Column 2 Schedule 2 to this Order from the road specified in Column one of Schedule 2.

#### Part III

## 5.Exemption

Nothing in Article 3 and 4 of this order nothing in this Article shall apply to any police, fire brigade or ambulance vehicle on an emergency call.

#### **PART IV**

## 6.Saving

In so far as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision which is contained in an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment then the provisions of THIS Order shall prevail.

The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
