

The County Council of Durham
(A689 South Church Road, Kingsway and Newgate Street and Fore
Bondgate, Bishop Auckland) (Temporary Road Closure)
Order 2024

The Council on 1/11/2024 made the above Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, to Prohibit all vehicular traffic from proceeding on the following lengths of road. A 190 metre length of the A689 South Church Road that extends generally easterly from its junction with Princes Street Roundabout; a 63 metre length of Kingsway that extends northwards from its junction with the A689 South Church Road and a 630 metre length of Fore Bondgate and Newgate Street, between the rising bollard and the junction with A689 Newgate Street crossroads. Incorporating a 10 metre length of Victoria Avenue and a 20 metre length of Tenter Street to enable carriageway resurfacing works to be undertaken. An alternative route will be available to traffic from the western side of the closure, from A689 Princes Street roundabout south on Bob Hardisty Drive, onto Cockton Hill Road then north easterly on A688 to A689 South Church Road Roundabout to the south eastern side of the closure, or continuing north easterly on A688 to the Canney Hill Roundabout then generally westerly on Durham Road, to the eastern side of the closure, and vice versa. The maximum duration of the Order is 18 months. The proposed works are required between 7pm-6am from Sunday 10/11/2024 and for the duration of the works, anticipated to be 7 nights. On occasions, alternative dates for the closure may be necessary and these will be signed on site accordingly.
