The County Council of Durham (Bridleway Number 28, Fylands Bridge, Bishop Auckland) (Temporary Bridleway Closure) Order 2024

The Council on 25/10/2024 made the above Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, to prohibit all traffic from proceeding on the following lengths of bridleway. A 202 metre length of Bridleway Number 28 Bishop Auckland Parish, that extends westerly from the A6072 West Auckland Road, Bishop Auckland to enable emergency clearance and reinstatement works to be undertaken to the bridleway. Alternative routes will be available to pedestrian traffic locally via Footpath 30, with other routes available for cycle and equestrian traffic via the highway network. The maximum duration of the Order is 6 months. The closure is required from 28/10/2024 and for a period of up to 6 months. On occasions, alternative dates for the closure may be necessary and these will be signed on site accordingly.
