

The County Council of Durham
(Public Right of Way, Footpath Numbers 1 & 10, Cassop-cum
Quarrington Parish, Bowburn) (Temporary Footpath Closure)
Order 2024

The Council proposes to make an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, to prohibit all pedestrian traffic from proceeding on the following lengths of footpath. A 620 metre length of Footpath Number 1 Cassop-cum-Quarrington Parish, that extends generally westwards from its inception near Bowburn Services at the A688. Also a 940 metre length of Footpath Number 10 that extends south westwards, between its junctions with Edna Street, Bowburn and Footpath Number 1, Cassop-cum-Quarrington Parish, to enable Integra 61 development works to be undertaken. Alternative routes are available to pedestrian traffic via the network of rights of way and footways on the site in the Bowburn / Tursdale area. The maximum duration of the Order is 6 months. The proposed works are required from Monday 18/11/2024 and the anticipated duration of the closure which is 6 months (which may be extended after this period). On occasions, alternative dates for the closure may be necessary and these will be signed on site accordingly.
